On March 1, 2006 David Peleg, Israeli Ambassador to Poland and Maciej Kozlowski, Polish ambassador-at-large for Jewish Affairs visited the Piast Institute as part of a tour that included Washington, D.C., Chicago and New York in addition to Detroit.
