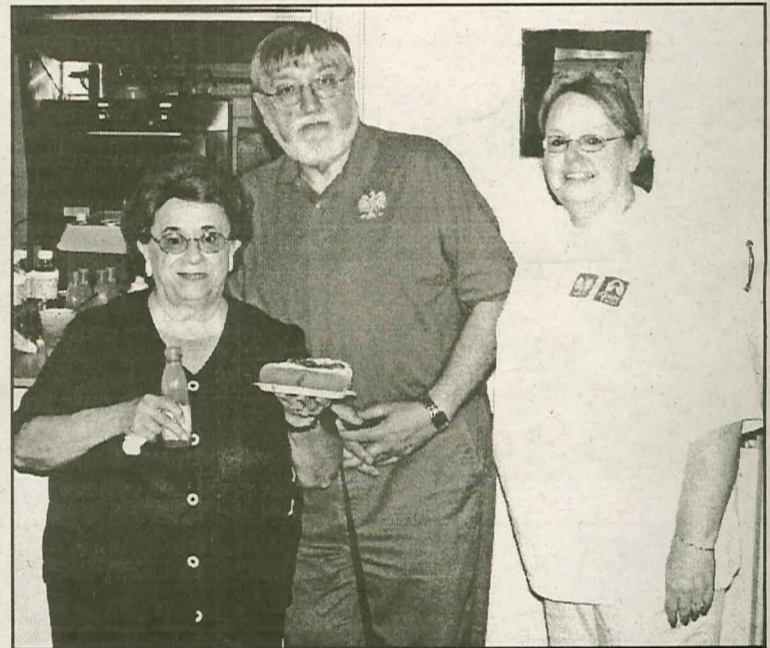
International Health Fair
